CMGT Education Excellence

Notes from the Chair

This past year, we worked together to strive for excellence. We achieved exceptional student success, industry engagement, and faculty productivity.

First, we successfully completed the 6th ACCE accreditation. The Accreditation Visiting Team toured ECU from February 13th through 15th, 2022, and came up with a report resulting in department strengths in the faculty, leadership, and industry support with their only concerns to increasing faculty positions and improving IT equipment for student learning. The CMGT undergraduate program received accreditation for six years, from February 2023 to February 2029.

Second, with the Industry Advisory Board (IAB) support, we successfully organized Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 IAB meetings at ECU, Fall 2022 IAB meeting at Caterpillar, Inc. in Clayton, NC; CONTECH Forums in Fall 2021 and 2022, and IAB Golf Tournament in Fall 2021 and 2022. The career fairs in 2021 and 2022 had approximately 96 and 125 participating construction companies respectively, held at the Greenville Convention Center.

We provided various opportunities to promote student success, starting with hands-on learning opportunities created by our faculty, industry partners, and student leaders. These included the Blockfest contests in Fall 2021 and Spring/Fall 2022, visiting Old Castel facilities in Durham, NC; NAHB Student Competition in February 2022; field trips to Caterpillar, Inc., and ST Wooten sites. More

than ever, industry and alumni guest speakers visited our classrooms, labs, and student organizations to present and connect our students with real construction projects.

It is important to provide a few examples of our recent student success:

- In February 2022, eight students participated in the NAHB competition in Orlando; 12 students will go to Las Vegas for the 2023 competition.
- Senior student Mr. Paxton Hemphill received the third-place award in the 2022 James L. Allhands Essay Contest by AGC.
- Graduate student, Md. Hasibul Rahat was recognized with the ECU International Student Award.
- Graduate student, Mohamad Khalid, received the Jimmie Hinz Best Paper in CIB Wogg & W123 Annual International conference in spring 20022, titled "Safety Implications of Using UAVs in Construction: An Ethical Perspective" and Editors' Choice Recognition of Journal Paper, titled "Insidious Safety Threat of Fatigue: Investigating Construction Workers' Risk of Accident Due to Fatigue," by the ASCE Journal of Construction Engineering & Management.

With the industry and pirate alumni's generous support, for 2022-2023, 35 students received various scholarships valued at approximately \$51,000, a 20% increase from last academic year.

Faculty and staff-wide, we are deeply sorry for our loss of Dr. Batie in June 2022 and Ms. Amy Taylor in July 2022. The department says goodbye and hello to multiple people within the ECU community:


- Dr. Syed Ahmed resigned from his faculty position in early 2022.

Other Faculty Activities

Dr. Yilei Huang received a **Course Innovation Grant from the ECU Office for Faculty Excellence** to introduce more hands-on and team collaboration activities in **CMGT 3010 Construction Modeling and Information Technology**. These interactive activities include a Lego house-building experience using a BIM model (pictures here) and VR presentations for students' final project (pictures here).

Dr. Yilei Huang has brought the **full capabilities of the new Leica FlexLine TSo3 total stations that the department acquired in 2020 into CMGT 2950/2951 Construction Surveying and Lab**. With 12 sets of the new generation of surveying equipment in every lab, our students are split into smaller groups for more hands-on time and can perform jobsite surveying and layout tasks more efficiently.

Dr. Yilei Huang presented the paper "Point Clouds vs 360° Photos: Comparing the Workflow and Benefits of Viewing Laser Scans in VR" at the 2021 ASCE International Conference on Computing in Civil Engineering in Orlando, FL in September 2021.

Dr. Yilei Huang was selected by the Associated Schools of Construction to attend the VDC Boot Camp at California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo, CA, in June 2022. The faculty boot camp allowed Dr. Huang to obtain new teaching materials for course development, network with fellow Construction Management faculty across the country, and receive training for industry-trending software in estimating, reality capture, and drone photogrammetry, including as Bluebeam Revu, Autodesk Construction Cloud, StructionSite, and DroneDeploy.

Dr. Carol Massarra was recognized for her **outstanding contribution as a Student Employee Supervisor** in Spring 2022.

Dr. Carol Massarra was accepted to the **2022 Graduate Writing Workshop**. The workshop took place in **Summer 1** and the goal of the workshop was to create a Canvas- based module around graduate writing that is focused enough to the discipline.

Dr. Carol Massarra attended the **Roofing Alliance Faculty Retreat** in Tempe, Arizona in **October 2022**. The Roofing Alliance Faculty Retreat was designed to educate faculty members about roofing-specific initiatives, including different types of roof systems available, best safety practices, key elements of roof design, technical and building code issues, sustainable roof system options, career opportunities and more.

Dr. Mostafa Namian was recognized for his **outstanding contribution as a Student Employee Supervisor** of East Carolina University in **Spring 2022**.

Dr. Mostafa Namain was featured as the **2021 Editor's Choice** in the Journal of Construction Engineering and Management for their paper called *Insidious Safety Threat of Fatigue: Investigating Construction Workers' Risk of Accident Due to Fatigue.* **Dr. Mostafa Namian** was recognized in **Spring 2022** in the Graduate Student Survey from a student as **"The person at ECU who made the most significant positive contribution to his/her education."**

2022 NAHB National Competition Team

The mission of the NAHB four-year student competition is to expose students to an in-depth residential construction project from concept to closing. This includes Market Analysis, Product and Site Design, Construction Management (estimate & schedule), Sustainability, Sales & Marketing, Financial, and Risk Analysis. Using real projects, students compete with other schools as they display their problem-solving abilities and learn more about home building. Student teams submit a written proposal (about 100 pages) for judging by a panel of industry professionals and then travel to the International Builder's Show (IBS) to give a live presentation of their proposals.

Eight East Carolina University students in the Construction Management department participated in the NAHB Student Competition at the International Builders Show in Orlando, Florida in February 2022. They ranked 16 out of 37 teams that participated and were led by Faculty Daniel Thomas and Susan Castelli. In January 2022 another group of twelve students will patriciate in the NAHB Student Competition in Las Vegas, Nevada.
